1. That a liquidation committee be established if sufficient nominations are received

1. In order for their votes to be counted creditors must submit to me their completed voting form so that it is received at DCA Business Recovery, 18 Clarence Road, Southend on Sea, Essex SS1 1AN by no later than 23.59 hours on 10 October 2023. It must be accompanied by a proof of debt, (if not already lodged). Failure to do so will lead to their vote(s) being disregarded.
2. Creditors must lodge a proof of debt (if not already lodged) at the offices of DCA Business Recovery by no later than 23.59 on 10 October 2023, without which their vote will be invalid.
3. Creditors with claims of £1,000 or less must have lodged a proof of debt for their vote to be valid.
4. Any creditors who have previously opted out from receiving documents in respect of the insolvency proceedings are entitled to vote on the decision(s) provided they have lodged a proof of debt.
5. Creditors may, within 5 business days of delivery of this notice to them, request a physical meeting of creditors be held to determine the outcome of the decision(s) above. Any request for a physical meeting must be accompanied by a valid proof of debt (if not already lodged). A meeting will be convened if creditors requesting a meeting represent a minimum of 10% in value or 10% in number of creditors or simply 10 creditors, where "creditors" means "all creditors."
6. Creditors have the right to appeal a decision of the convener made under Chapter 8 of Part 15 of The Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 about Creditors' Voting Rights and Majorities, by applying to court under Rule 15.35 of The Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 within 21 days of 10 October 2023 the Decision Date.
